



About Us

The North Valley Chorale (NVC) is a volunteer, nonprofit **501(c)(3)** community choir established 2008. We are dedicated to the **cultural, musical, and social enrichment** of metropolitan Phoenix. Our 60+ singers, aged 21- 80, hail from across the Valley.

We serve our community by providing **affordable and accessible** performances of **choral music** from many traditions, eras and cultures. Our repertoire ranges from classical to pop, patriotic, gospel and Broadway. We have released four CDs, including the 10th anniversary *Celebrate* set, are featured on local television, premier new works and produced virtual streaming and on-demand performances during the pandemic.

The NVC is proud to be known as "**the choir that cares.**" We share our gifts of music, companionship and goods with the needy, ill and homeless. Our community partners include St. Mary's Food Bank, Lost Our Home, Feed My Starving Children, UMOM shelters, the Banner Alzheimer Institute (BAI), St. Matthew's School, St. Vincent de Paul and local food pantries, the Duet partnership for health and aging, and senior living communities.

We usually perform 3 local concerts per year and have graced the stages of **Kennedy Center** (Washington, DC), **Carnegie Hall** and **Radio City Music Hall** (New Your City, NY), the **Herberger Theater** and the **Orpheum Theater** (Phoenix, AZ).

The NVC has **toured internationally**. In 2016, we performed in **Germany, Austria** and the **Czech Republic**, in 2019 we entertained locals and tourists in **England, Scotland, Ireland** and **France** and in 2023 will look forward to **Spain** and **Portugal!**

For singers interested in joining the NVC, rehearsals are Wednesday evenings and some Sundays at the Phoenix Boys Choir, 1131 E. Missouri Ave, Phoenix. Learn more at www.northvalleychorale.org. Auditions by appointment.

When she is not teaching or directing, Eleanor enjoys her grandchildren, hiking, gardening, crossword puzzles and traveling with Graham, her love for over 40 years.


